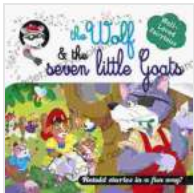


Wolf and the Goats: A Timeless Tale for Children

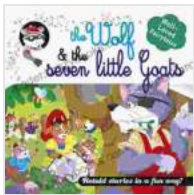

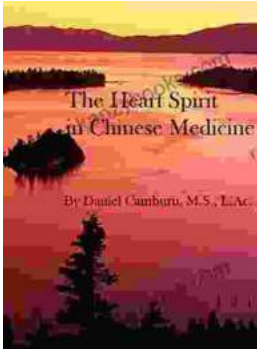

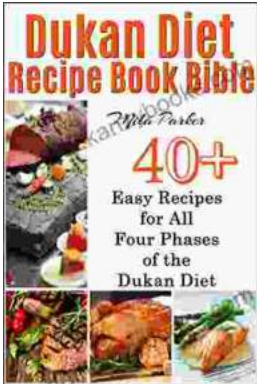
